- All Farms growing a crop $>5000$ sqft
- No-till still needs a plan
- In some cases permanent hay/pasture not needed
- Farms with Animal Concentration Areas (ACA)
- Conservation Plan VS Ag E\&S Plan
- DEP Ch91 (Manure Management)
- PA Manure Management Manual - workbook
- Act 38 or 590 NMP
- PA One Stop

## Changes Comping to Both

- Some Things Already Changed
- Milking wash water
$\square$ Things That Will Change?
- CAO Calculation
- Signature requirement
- Manure volume calculations
- Near stream areas????
$\square$ Currently under development at DEP
$\square$ Must be published before enacted
- Review comment period


## Nutrient \& Odor Management Plans

- Act 38 of 2005
- Replaced Act 6
- Required P management
- $>2$ AEUs/ac $=$ NMP (CAO)
- 1000lbs of live animal weight = 1 AU
- AEUs are adjusted for productions days
- CAFOs must comply with Act 38


## NMP vs. MMP

- NMP
- Requires soil tests, manure analyses
- Field specific
- 3yr plan
- Reviewed and approved by CCD
- MMP
- Don't need soil and manure analysis
- Crop specific
- No expiration date


## The "Act" is going to be open for changes

$\square$ Proposed changes are being worked on now
$\square$ Both Nutrient \& Odor
$\square$ Many will actually make the process better
$\square$ Will be published next year

- 90 day public comment period
- Anyone can comment (ie Environmental Groups)
$\square$ This process will take several years


## CAFOs in Pennsylvania

- Concentrated $\underline{\text { Animal }}$ Feeding $\underline{\text { Operations }}$
- Federal regulation
- States can adopt own regs or default to Feds
- PA adopted its own regs
- NPDES permit (general or individual)
- Determined by watershed right now
- Might be needed for >1000AEUs
- Required if >= Federal animal threshold number OR
- >300AEUs and >2AEUs/ac
- Additional requirements in NMP, recordkeeping, setbacks, manure storage and more...


## Changes Coming to GP

## CAFOs

- Out for comment right now
- Likely go into effect 1/1/2023
- ALL MUST BE RENEWED BY 3/31/2023
$\square$ Additional requirements
- BMP Checklist for TMDL Watersheds
- Barnyard Runoff / Manure Storages
- Manure Treatment / Transport
- Precision feeding / rotational grazing
- Fencing \& Riparian buffers
- Mortality management


## Changes Coming to Individual Permit

- Nothing definitive now
- Was told "we will be looking at that after we get done with the GPs"
- Already capable of putting in special conditions
